

## My Experience

I was born and live in Botswana. I grew up going to the London Missionary Society church (from the Church of England) which is a Sunday keeping church. In 1985 I was introduced to Sister Ellen G. White's writings through Bible studies and I was mostly impressed by the message of the Sabbath and the health message. I was the same year baptized into the Seventh Day Adventist Church organization membership which I then believed was the only commandment keeping church organisation in the world.

Through the years I discovered that there were some problems of apostasy in the SDA church but I believed that I was supposed to remain in the Church at all costs.

In 2008 I discovered some Spirit of Prophecy material from [lightministries.com](http://lightministries.com) proving the close of probation of Seventh-Day Adventist Church. The message was clear and I decided to leave the Seventh-Day Adventist Church Organisation.

At that time I was looking for information showing whether the writings of Sister White were changed. In my search I came across the [SOPVindicated.org](http://SOPVindicated.org) website which had the original books of the pioneers and the original writings of Sister Ellen G. White. It became more clear how the Spirit of Prophecy writings were changed. I then sent an email to brother Art who mailed some CD's containing all the writings of both the pioneers and Sister White. These have helped me and my family a lot.

We have since disassociated ourselves as a family from Seventh-Day Adventist Church Organisation. We worship alone as a family at our home.

All along we have cherished true education which is not found in the SDA schools so we homeschool our kids. My wife has always been teaching them at home. And at the moment the boy is 16 and the girl is 14. So we need a place where they could do further Bible based vocational training. They are interested in music, sewing, carpentry and medical missionary.

To avoid the corruption and pollution of the city in 2010 we moved to the farm in the country. But for me I could not move completely to the farm I still have to come back to work in the city (100km away) due to the loans which I incurred the years.

We are also looking for people we could associate with who share the same beliefs like we do. If there is good music and sermons from such people it will be great for us.
